The Scottish Agricultural Science Agency complex in Edinburgh features the Hy-ten Gabion 700 System.

Extensive use of gabions for twenty one retaining - landscape walls ranging in height from 1.4m to 5m, the walls were part retaining and part freestanding defining boundaries of paths and car parking areas.

A two coloured granite rock fill was chosen to give a pleasing visual effect

The scheme was originally designed with Standard Woven gabions, had the scheme been constructed in the woven gabions the crisp lines and planar faces would have been difficult to achieve.

Hy-ten in consultation with the Architect and the Main contractor progressed the design with the 700 Gabion system resulting in a high quality design that provided an overall saving in the volume of gabions required.

In the Foyer, the wall was clad in gabions to provide the visual effect of the external wall passing into the foyer.
